

Monti Community Center Meeting

Nov. 22, 2009

The regular meeting of the Monti Community Center was called to order by V. Pres. Tom Reidy. Members present were: Tom & Carla Reidy, Teresa Reidy, Jim & Lois Loughren, Kelly & Lacy Short, Dean Bovenmyer, Sean Dolan, and Al & Kathy Wulfekuhle.

The minutes were read and approved.

The financial report was given. There is \$7758 in checking and the remainder, approximately \$23,000 is split between a CD, bond and money market. The CD comes due shortly and a motion was made to renew the CD by Sean Dolan and a 2nd was made by Al Wulfekuhle. The fall fest netted \$1289. Over the past year the lease income has increased. We did have some major expenses with the septic system, concrete work and electrical updating. As of now operations are maintaining the normal maintenance expenses. The financial report was then approved by Al Wulfekuhle and a 2nd was made by Jim Loughren.

Hoover Church recently rented the hall for a supper. From that event, there have been inquiries on how to become a member. With this being the 5th year of the initial membership, we are looking for suggestions on how to increase the membership. Further discussion on this topic was tabled until the next meeting. It was also noted that there are still 13 outstanding dues from members.

A recount of the election from the previous meeting was taken and the votes stand as is.

Lacey Short commented on the new web site. The address is monticc.com; we hope everyone checks it out. An update on the additional parking across the street by Matrona Moroney's was given. They hope to have dirt moved in by this winter so it can settle and be ready for use in the spring. There was also discussion on possibly a new lock on the front door, only because several people have difficulty getting the key to work. There will also be a look taken at the roof to see if there are any new signs of wear on it.
